YOU WERE MISSED

Please follow the directions of the ushers and other ministers of hospitality

Anyone who wishes to attend Mass should be healthy. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass remains in effect.

Please wear a mask. Sanitize your hands. Keep 6 feet apart.

Please choose a pew that is open and not roped off. Those of the same household may sit together.

Please be attentive to the markings on the floor which indicate 6 feet of separation.

We are not able to use missalettes for the time being.

There is no congregational singing.

Bulletins will be handed out by ministers of hospitality.

There will be no Sign of Peace. No Offertory Procession with the bread and wine. There will be no Altar Servers and no Choir.

If you wish to light a candle please seek the assistance of one of the ministers of hospitality. You may pray at the altar rail but keep the 6 feet rule in mind.

For The Reception of Holy Communion

Please follow the directions of the ushers and other ministers of hospitality

For the reception of Holy Communion everyone will wear their mask as they approach the altar for Holy Communion. Keep your mask on until you have received the Body of Christ. Step aside to the X mark on the floor, and remove your mask then consume the Body of Christ then replace your mask and proceed down the side aisle to the back of the church and approach your pew from the back of the Church in the same single aisle that is approaching for Communion.

We will only be using the main aisle. Please form a single line staying 6 feet apart as the markings on the floor indicate.

We will begin with the center aisle first. Those sitting on the sides will follow the main aisle.

For those sitting in the main aisle, please begin with those sitting at the front. Form one line. There will be two ministers to distribute the Body of Christ. Go to either minister, step aside to the X mark on the floor, remove your mask, consume the Body of Christ, then replace your mask and proceed back to your pew by going down the side aisle to the back of the church and approach your pew from the back of the church in the single file of those approaching Communion until you reach your pew.

For those sitting on the sides, please begin with those in the back of the church and proceed toward the back of the church and then proceed to the main aisle. Proceed down the main aisle in a single line as you approach the altar for the reception of Holy Communion. Go to either minister. Receive the Body of Christ, step aside to the X mark on the floor, remove your mask and consume the Body of Christ then replace your mask and proceed down the side aisle toward the back of the church until you reach your pew.

Leaving the Church after Mass

After the conclusion of mass, a minister of hospitality will approach your pew in the main aisle to exit the Church. You will be leaving by order of your pew. The back pews will be exiting first and move up the aisle until the minister of hospitality reaches the front of the Church. For seating on the side aisles you will exit after all the worshipers have exited the main aisle.
