




CELEBRATION OF FIRST EUCHARIST

RCIA REGISTRATION

The process is intended for adults: (1) who were never baptized; (2) those baptized in another Christian faith who wish to become Catholic; and (3) those baptized Catholic, but did not make their First Holy Communion or Confirmation...
