

CELEBRATING OUR FAITH

This week we are celebrating two important feasts in our lives a people of God. Today is the Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the last Sunday of the Church year. Its official title is the Solemnity of Christ the King. This solemnity was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 celebrating an aspect of Jesus' identity rather than his life. Rather than recalling images of Jesus in kingly robes, the gospel proclaims him as king by the sign over his head on the cross (I.N.R.I. - JESUS NAZAŘENUS REX IUDAEORUM, Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews). Jesus did not live up to the expectations of the people of his time who expected a Messiah who was a descendant of King David and would free them from the Romans and establish a Jewish kingdom, like David did. Instead, Jesus led a simple life, teaching God's mercy and forgiveness.



Gratitude is an attitude that we should carry with us each day of the year. St. Paul encouraged people through his letter to the Colossians to "dedicate yourselves to thankfulness ..."
