RCIA

Are you considering becoming Catholic? Do you know someone who is being called to join our faith? RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the process through which adults are received into the Catholic Church. The process is intended for adults: (1) who were never baptized; (2) those baptized in another Christian faith who wish to become Catholic; and (3) those baptized Catholic, but did not make their First Holy Communion or Confirmation. We offer an online, self-paced RCIA program that consists of a combination of Catholic videos on Formed, as well as hardcopy reading materials from Liguori to provide a solid understanding of the Catholic faith. Classes run all year, so you can begin the process when you are ready. The selfpaced program allows you to complete the program at a pace that is right for you.
