



## EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

#### When God Speaks Like a Polish Grandmother

A friend of mine had a Polish grandmother who was famous for giving her children some blunt advice every time they left the house: "Eyes straight ahead. Mind your own business."

Every mother knows her children best, and this mother knew hers liked to argue and sometimes like to show off. She knew that could lead to trouble. She could not anticipate every scenario they would encounter each time they departed from her. All she could do was distill what she knew about life, safety, and manners into a few simple words, and hand them over to her children like a set of car keys or a hastily scribbled map. In this way, a woman who rarely said "I love you" expressed her devotion. And long after she was dead and buried, her aging sons and daughters repeated these words to them selves, like a child wrapping himself in a warm blanket.

Jesus does much the same for us, in many portions of the Gospels. "Ask the master to send out laborers for His harvest...Carry no money... Eat what is set before you...Know that the Kingdom of God is at hand...Rejoice because your names are written in Heaven."

He knows us best - knows our strengths, but even more importantly, He knows our weaknesses. He doesn't always have the space to address each of these explicitly in the pages of Scripture, but what He can do is distill the truth of effective evangelization into a few simple words, and hand them over to us as food for our journey of discipleship.

In this way, a God who addresses the entire world and every soul who ever lived also speaks intimately to each one of us.

Parish contribution plan for fulfill Ch. 11 settlement terms: Downtown Family of Parishes, #22.

"The participation of the entire Catholic family is necessary to bring to a close this painful chapter of our Diocese and achieve a level of restitution that is owed to the many who have had to carry the tremendous burden of physical, emotional and spiritual harm of sexual abuse throughout their lives."-Bishop Michael W. Fisher.

Contribution percentages range from 10 to 80 percent of each parish's 'unrestricted' savings, its interest and investments. Nothing is being taken from operating funds. Those parishes on the possible closed or merged list waiting for decisions from the Vatican are asked for 80% of assets. 50% of the parishes of the diocese have claims. All proceeds provided through insurance carriers would be added to collected parish suggested contributions.

- St. Michael-80% at \$2.4 million. PAID. A percentage will be given back if St. Michaels would stay open.
- Bl. Sacrament-originally 25% at \$80K, minus new roof cost, now 10% at \$22,350. PAID
- St. Anthony of Padua Oratory, 45%, \$261K. PAID
- St. Joseph Cathedral- No contribution made.
- St. Louis-75%, \$3.2 million. Contribution To Be Determined.

I would like to thank all the parishioners who have been supportive in this very painful time to our clergy and Diocese. A HUGE thank you to the parishioners, 'the angels', who have written the parish donation checks to help cover these contributions. Please be assured that ANY weekly donations will not leave the parish and are not applied to any contribution to the bankruptcy settlement. We will get through this together and begin to move on as a church and Diocese.

#### **DEVOTIONS, EXPLAINED!**

#### St. Michael Prayer

#### Mini Explanation

The prayer to St. Michael, composed by Pope Leo XIII, invokes the protection of the Archangel Michael in the ongoing spiritual battle for the souls of all mankind. It is commonly said at the end of the rosary and by some parishes after the conclusion of Mass.

#### St. Michael Prayer, Explained!

The prayer to St. Michael invokes the protection of the Archangel Michael in the ongoing spiritual battle for the souls of all mankind. This prayer was composed by Pope Leo XIII and its use was instituted in 1886 at the end of Low Mass, a tradition which continued until the liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council. A popular story regarding its origin claims that he wrote this prayer after having a vision of demonic spirits descending on Rome.

Michael is mentioned as one of God's seven archangels in the Book of Enoch and is presented by Revelations 12:7-12 as the warrior angel who cast Satan from Heaven. He is therefore traditionally venerated as a protector against the forces of evil and guardian of the Church,
