

#### RETIREMENT FUND FOR RELIGIOUS

(Gal 6, 9). During these unprecedented times, many are hurting and need our assistance, including elderly religious

The 33rd annual Retirement Fund for Religious collection will be held next weekend December 12th and 13th. The appeal assists hundreds of religious order communities in providing for the ongoing needs of their aging Catholic sisters, brothers, and religious order priests.

The U.S. bishops initiated the collection in 1988 to address the significant lack of retirement funding among U.S. religious orders. The annual collection benefits eligible religious orders to help underwrite retirement and health-care expenses for nearly 30,000 elderly religious.


The retirement-funding deficit is rooted in low salaries and changing demographics. Traditionally women and men religious engaged in ministry for little to no pay. As a result, many religious communities lack adequate retirement savings. Elderly religious are also living longer and outnumber younger, wage-earning religious by nearly three to one.

This year the needs to be addressed are many. We ask for your prayerful support of our religious women and men and whatever donation you can make will be greatly appreciated.

# FIRST RECONCILIATION & FIRST EUCHARIST CLASS REGISTRATION

Children receiving the sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist this spring at St. Louis must be registered to do so by January 19, 2021. Registration forms can be downloaded from the St. Louis website (https://stlouisrcchurch.org) or emailed from the Director of Faith Formation, Ashlee Campbell (stlouisfaithformation@gmail.com). To prepare for these sacraments, children will attend in-person sacrament preparation classes. Classes are scheduled for 3 consecutive Saturdays, February 6th, February 20th, and February 27th. All classes will be from 9:30—11:30 a.m. in the church hall. Attendance at all three classes is mandatory.

#### **MISSALETTE GIVE-A-WAY**

When churches were permitted to re-open again in June there were several protocols that needed to be put in place in order to re-open safely. The wearing of masks, keeping distance from fellow parishioners, and hand sanitizing were among the most obvious.

Emptying the Holy Water Fonts and removing printed materials from the church were also required. Hymn books and other resources were to be removed from pews and entry ways and put in storage until the outbreak has passed.

Since the outbreak of Covid-19 has not passed and is indeed on the rise we will not be able to put the missalettes out in the church. As we come to the conclusion of one liturgical year and begin a new one, we have received new missalettes for the 2020-2021 liturgical year.

We will be distributing the missalettes to anyone who would like one. This weekend the greeters will be handing them out for private use. They are yours to keep for private use and use in church. Since we can't leave them out it was decided that those who want can have one to bring back and forth with them for Mass.


